Fireworks Safety

July is synonymous with barbecues, parades and fireworks. The National Safety Council advises everyone to enjoy fireworks at public displays conducted by professionals. Even though consumer fireworks are legal they are not entirely safe. In 2017, over 12,000 people were injured badly enough to require medical treatment after fireworks-related incidents. 50% of those injuries were to children and young adults under the age of 20. 2/3 of the injuries occurred from June 16 to July 16 and an estimated 1,200 injuries were from less powerful devices such as small firecrackers and sparklers which burn at about 2,000 degrees (hot enough to melt some metals). Additionally, fireworks start an average of 18,500 fires each year including 1,300 structure fires and 300 vehicle fires. It's best to leave the fireworks to the experts, but if you choose to use them, please be sure to check out these important safety tips at nsc.org/ home-safety/tools-resources/seasonal-safety/summer/ fireworks. Always be responsible when using consumer fireworks and soak spent fireworks in water before discarding them.

For a complete copy of the current Gerrish Township Fireworks Ordinance No. 45, effective September 27, 2020, please visit the Gerrish Township website or the Gerrish Township Police Department website. You can also stop in at the Gerrish P.D. and pick up a hard copy. Fireworks are permitted from June 29th to July 4th until 11:45 pm on each of those days. Cannot be used on public property, streets, school property, church property or from the property of another person without the owner's express written permission. Cannot be ignited or discharged by a person under the influence of alcohol or drugs. www.gerrishtownship.org/ordinances
