Gerrish Township Rescue American Rescue Plan Act



Through funding received from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, the Gerrish Township Board will be offering grant funding for qualifying projects. The Township will begin accepting grant applications on September 26, 2022. The application deadline is October 31, 2022 at 4:00 pm.

While the Township has chosen to retain \$250,113.26 for public safety and personal protection needs and infrastructure, \$60,000.00 has been allocated for other projects that are related to decreased revenues, financial insecurity, increased costs and negative economic impacts.

Eligible applicants are those that serve the Township as a non-profit organization or commercial enterprise. Proposed grant projects must address a need or negative impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Applications and further information regarding eligibility for grant funding can be obtained by visiting www.gerrishtownship.org or by emailing Gerrish Township ARPA Committee Chair at chief.hill@gerrishpolice.org. Applications are also available at the Gerrish Township main office.

Submitted proposals will be reviewed by the Gerrish Township American Rescue Plan Committee and evaluated against criteria provided by the US Treasury, American Rescue Plan Final Rules and the Township standards. Eligible proposals will be presented to the Gerrish Township Board on November 3, 2022 for funding consideration.
