TORCH RUN for Special Olympics

It's not too late to register for the Annual Gerrish Township Torch Run that will take place on September 13th at 6:00 pm. This is a 5K Run/ Bicycle/Walk event that starts at the Gerrish Twp. Police Department and ends at the South Higgins Lake State Park boat basin/pavilion area. Registration fee is \$25 and includes a run shirt. Fee is \$30 if you register on-line and your shirt will be shipped directly to you. Registration begins just before the run at 5:00 pm. Hot dogs, chips and water will be provided after the run along with bus transportation back to your vehicle at the Police Department. You can also register your dogs to run with you and for \$10 they will receive a run shirt also. Registration forms are available at the Gerrish Twp. All funds raised will support Special Olympics Michigan with a portion going directly to our local Area 4 Special Olympic athletes.



There are several ways that Gerrish Police and ACT NOW support keeping our community clean and beautiful. We provide a trailer and collect scrap metal throughout the summer as a way to dispose of unused scrap metal. This trailer is located behind the Gerrish Police Department next



to the fenced in area and scrap metal can be dropped off there anytime. When the trailer is full, volunteers will take it to the recycling center in Houghton Lake and all proceeds from our Scrap Metal Project go towards community programs and projects. The scrap metal trailer will be available through the middle of October.

We also do a Spring and Fall road clean-up each year through MDOT's Adopt-A-Highway program and clean both sides of County Road 100 from Pioneer Hill south to Hillsdale Drive. Our fall clean-up will take place on September 20th at 4:00 pm. If you would like to assist with clean-up please be at the Gerrish Police Department by 4:00 pm and you will be assigned a partner and a section of roadway. Safety vests, gloves, bags, buckets, and pokers will be provided. Afterwards, pizza and pop are provided for the volunteers as a way to thank those that participate. If you wold like to help out with the upcoming road clean-up please call Julie at (989) 821-5207 Ext. 291 so that we can get a head count for pizza.
