### CADET DYLAN SHARROW

On March 11, 2025, the Gerrish Township Board authorized Chief Muszynski to offer a Sponsorship to Dylan Sharrow to attend the Kirtland Regional Police Academy that will begin on August 11th and end on December 5th. Dylan applied

for a Sponsorship in December of 2024. Like many police agencies, Gerrish Twp. Police Department began offering Sponsorships to interested and eligible candidates to become law enforcement officers and receive their training and fulfill the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards (MCOLES) requirements while being employed by an agency. We began this program in July of 2023 to address the huge problem of

recruitment and retention of



law enforcement officers. Immediately upon graduation from the Academy, Dylan will begin his Field Training Program as a Full-Time Road Patrol Officer. Part of the funding for his Sponsorship will come from a Public Safety Academy Assistance Program Appropriation through MCOLES to assist with academy tuition fees, salary and benefits, and other associated academy costs.

Dylan has lived in Roscommon County his entire life and comes from a family of public safety service. He is excited to begin the Academy and start his Law Enforcement career. He states, "I am excited about the possibility of working at Gerrish Township given my strong ties to the area and the values your prestigious department has demonstrated over the years. I have a desire to work and live in a community that shares in those values...my heart belongs in Roscommon County and I am eager to start my career in Law Enforcement."

Our Department welcomes Dylan to our team and wishes him much success during his time at the Academy and as he embarks on his journey in a public safety career!
