The targeted play piece is a multi-child inclusive/accessible spinner for children ages 2-12 and includes the appropriate safety surfacing.

SCRAP METAL PROJECT

ACT NOW started their Scrap Metal Project in 2008 and it has run every year from April -October as a fundraiser to support all of the community programs and projects sponsored by ACT NOW and the Gerrish Twp. Police Dept. We have recently wrote some local grants to purchase a new dump-style trailer for this project as our old wooden trailer has become a bit worn and damaged over the years. Currently the trailer has to be unloaded by hand by volunteers that take the scrap metal to the recycling center throughout the season. The new trailer would have a 7,000-pound dual-axle capacity, steel construction, electric braking system with a scissor hoist for convenient and safer dumping. This trailer would be a couple feet longer and would allow for fewer trips to the recycling center as the smaller trailer fills quickly. The average load represents 2,072 pounds of metal and we average 17 trips to the recycling center each year bringing in approximately \$3,000.00 for the project annually.

We recently were awarded \$2,500.00 from the Roscommon Rotary Club towards this project

and we have submitted an application to the RCCF for \$4,000.00. ACT NOW will provide the remainder of the funding as the New Trailer Project total cost is \$9,524.00.
